Leaders of the Combined Charities of Ocean Reef were recently presented checks to benefit the vital local charities they represent, resulting from the Ocean Reef Community's participation in the 2010 All Charities Auction Weekend.

The All Charities Auction events, established by the Ocean Reef Foundation in 2008 to enable members to consolidate their support for charities community-wide over a single

weekend each year, netted almost \$1.4 million last February. Combined with the integral ORC Charity Check Off proceeds, the seven charities shared a total of more than \$1,675,500 as detailed here.
